We send you this fourth circular letter after having completed the evaluation process of the abstracts submitted to the academic committee. By this point, all those who submitted an abstract should have received an answer from the committee. Presentation titles:

For your convenience, we have updated [the conference webpage](#) with a [list of the speakers at the conference and the titles of their presentations](#). We ask you to locate your name and title on the list, and, should you like to make any changes, please let us know by May 14. After this date, we will not be able to make any further changes to the presentation titles.

Schedule:

The conference will begin with greetings and the keynote lecture on Sunday, June 25, at 18:00. The registration desk will be staffed from 15:00 on Sunday, June 25. You are also invited to an English-language tour of the Mt. Scopus campus on opening day, between 16:00 and 17:00.

The conference will end at 18:00 on Wednesday, June 28.

The excursion to Caesarea will take place on Thursday, June 29, and is expected to end between 16:00 and 18:00. Partners and guests are welcome to join.

Fees:

After much effort, we have succeeded in reducing the conference fee to **130 USD**. As mentioned in a previous letter, the fee will cover the participation in all sessions, dinner reception, coffee, and lunch during the conference (at the Maiersdorf Faculty Club). Students and post-doctorates are exempt from the conference fee and invited to all receptions and meals.

The fee for the Caesarea excursion will be **35 USD** and will include lunch. Students and post-doctorates who wish to join the excursion will be required to pay the excursion fee. Guests who will not be attending the conference are also welcome to join the Caesarea excursion for the same fee.

We are still in the process of creating an online platform for payment of the conference and excursion fees. We will notify you once the payment system is up and provide you with further instructions.
